

The Rev. David Wiggs has been Senior Pastor at Boston Avenue Church since June, 2013. A number of new ministries have been initiated since his coming - from spiritual formation to recovery groups to a weeknight dinner and worship experience offered to those living with mental illness.

He is a native of Okmulgee, Oklahoma, and a graduate of the University of

Oklahoma. He earned his Master of Theology degree at St. Paul Theological Seminary in Kansas City, Missouri, and was named a Distinguished Alumnus of the seminary last year.

Rev. Wiggs served at Christ United Methodist Church in Tulsa as an associate minister prior to coming to Boston Avenue the first time in 1987. He served as associate minister and youth director at Boston Avenue from 1987 until 2000. During David's last three years at Boston Avenue, he transitioned from Youth Ministry into Evangelism. In 2000, he was appointed Senior Minister at First United Methodist Church in Enid. After serving ten successful years in Enid, he was appointed as Superintendent of the Stillwater District. There he focused his efforts on developing strong lay-clergy partnerships for leadership of the local churches. He also has played a key role in developing a new vision for the OSU Wesley Foundation and helped launch them into a 15 million dollar capital campaign to change the face of ministry and the spiritual impact on campus of the United Methodist Church.

David and his wife Mary have two daughters. Grace is employed here in Tulsa with Brian D. Wiggs Homes and is engaged to be married in April. Younger daughter Hope is a student at Oklahoma City University.
