Good news is that bone marrow biopsy came back clean so they can use his marrow if needed! We are so thankful! He is still very sore from the surgery four weeks ago, and just ready to get on with it. One trip in the car wears him out..."
- Paula Scot's brother is responding to chemo treatment for his tumor, please keep in your prayers.
- Please add Debbie to the Maranatha prayer list. The serious concussion she had in June has turned out to have resulted in identifying a growth in her sphenoid sinuses which may be a leakage of brain fluid into the sinus from a fracture of the bone around the sinus, a polyp and fungus growing in the sinus, or perhaps a tumor. The growth seen on the C-T is unclear as to source but has to be removed and then a source of treatment determined. Unless something changes, she scheduled this week to have surgery at St. Anthony's hospital in OKC on December 2. If everything goes well the surgery will be a reasonably quick recovery.
