Here is the blurb about them as published on the before mentioned websites:





Two stunning oil paintings of the New Mexico landscape by acclaimed Santa Fe artist Anthony Corso. One is 24" x 36"; the other is 23" x 15". The larger work depicts buttes jutting up from the floor of a valley into mesas with a distant mountain range in the background. The smaller work is of clouds hovering over a distant mountain range. Both paintings features the colors of the high desert; gold's, rose, turquoise and green. Using the rich colors of the southwest, Corso captures the stark beauty of a New Mexico landscape. Corso's work has been featured in solo shows, group exhibitions and at numerous galleries including: The Empire Collection, New York, NY; La Galleria at La Mama, New York, NY; Hankook Gallery, New York, NY; Robertson Gallery, Beverly Hills, CA; Riggs Gallery, La Jolla, CA; Labyrintus, Budapest, Hungary. His work in public collections includes those of the United Nations, the Port Authority of New York, Chemical Bank and the American Broadcasting Company. More information about the artist, who is presently living in New York may be found at his website.

These paintings were donated to Maranatha Ministries by the original owner. Proceeds will be used for community service work in the Tulsa, OK. area.
